**Lake Chelan School District
Alternative Learning Experience Program**

The district establishes the alternative learning experience program as provided over the internet or by other electronic means as defined in WAC 391-121-182. In addition, the district establishes the “Glacier Valley High School” and the “Chelan Preparatory High School”, alternative learning experience program provided on site as defined in WAC 392-121-182.

Every student enrolled in these programs shall have a written individual plan developed in collaboration with the student, the student’s parent(s) or guardian, and/or other interested parties.

The curriculum and course requirements for the program must be approved by the district pursuant to policy.

Each student enrolled in an alternative learning experience program shall have direct personal contact with school staff at least weekly, to discuss and evaluate student progress, until completion of the course objectives or the requirements of the learning plan. Direct personal contact means a face-to-face meeting with the student, and if appropriate, with the parent(s) or guardian. Personal contact may be accomplished through the use of telephone, email, instant messaging, interactive video communications or other means of digital communication.

Each student's records, including his or her plan, enrollment records, attendance records, student progress reviews, evaluations, and assessments, and records of total hours of participation in educational activities must be maintained and kept available for audit.

The district alternative learning program shall satisfy the state board of education requirements for courses of study or equivalencies; and if the program offers credit or a high school diploma, the alternative learning program must meet the minimum high school graduation requirements.
