After School Tutoring in the Library.

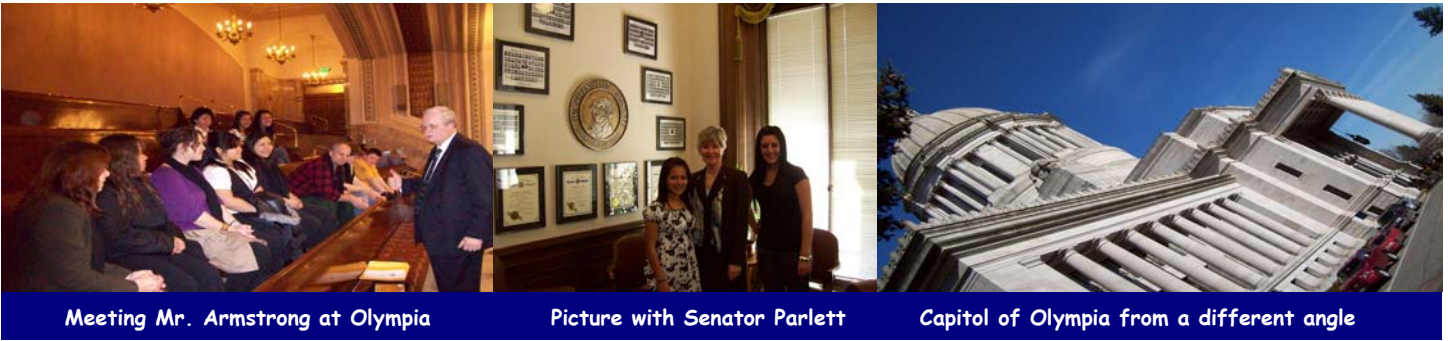

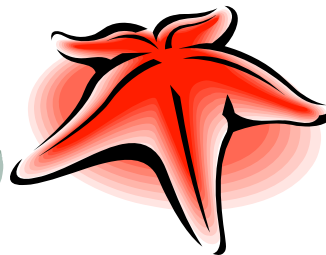
Field trip to Wenatchee Skills Center in October 2009.
