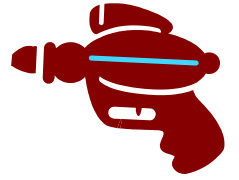
The theme of this movie is "More Than Meets the Eye". So I think what it is trying to say is that the cars are really robots that transform before you know it.

La La la

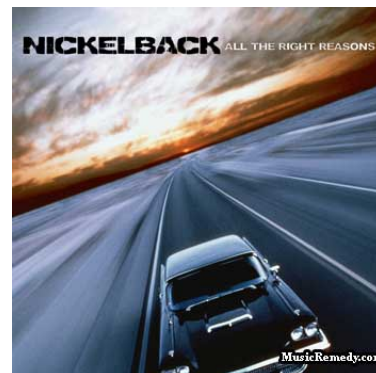

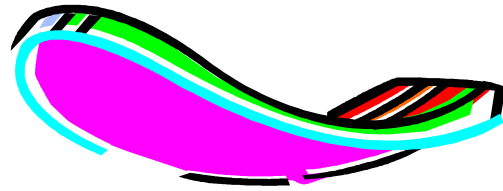
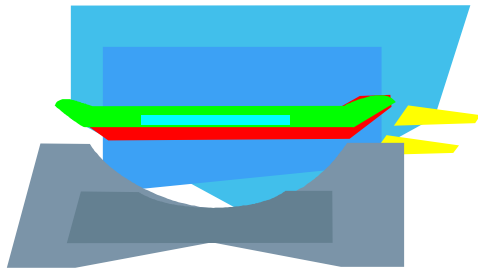
pay. Families can also help. If the injured person needs a little bit of money their family will help them.
