“Oink, Oink!” That’s you, right after a life saving pig organ transplant. You’d be thinking *I’m half pig.*

In a study of some of the people with pig transplants over the past 12 years, 0 out of 160 have not died or developed disease, that’s about 10 or more years to live that you didn’t have before. So if you had to choose a pig organ or die, which one would you pick? Unfortunately some people have had other animal transplants, like baboon transplants. Within 45 days they bit the dust.

Although some pig transplants can save lives, not all of them are successful. In some rare cases, you can develop very deadly diseases such as Ebola and AIDS. You can get these if the pig isn’t 100% healthy, if the pig already had the disease, or your body doesn’t to the organ. Even if you developed the disease, you still might live for another 5 years or so.

Finally, is that 28,000 Americans die from liver failure each year. There are only 3,150 people who can donate an organ so, year that’s only 3,150 recipients a year that live out of 28,000. Yet if

we use pig transplants, we might be able to save thousands more. If you were in that position, where you had to get a new liver would you “A” get a pig organ or “B” risk waiting for a liver from a human. What would you pick, live or die?

That’s why I think why we should donate because we can save lives and there are not enough people to donate, so pigs are the answer. So would you rather be half pig or die? It’s your pick, live, or bite the dust.

## Do you really want pig organs in you?????

I think they should not put pig organs in humans because they cause diseases and pig viruses can spread. Also, pig organs are already being traded in South America. One of the deadliest group disease, comes from pigs. It ranges in seriousness from relatively mild illnesses to severe and potentially fatal diseases. All forms of the fever begin with muscle aches depending on the virus. The diseases can get worse until the patient becomes very ill with breathing problems, kidney problems and shock.

Pig organs should not be used for transplants because they cause diseases such as Ebola and Aids. Children are especially prone to these diseases as they develop immunities. The lack of specialized health care in South America prevents timely intervention. Some dis-

eases are treatable with vaccines, but most are not, they can only treat the symptoms.

Viruses can spread because about 160 people had diseases. The children could die and unknown viruses may be transferred across the species. In china, a highly infectious swine virus is sweeping china's pig population, driving up pork prices and creating fears of global pandemic among domesticated pigs.

Organs are already being traded in South Central America so I was thinking that we could have a donation center. Also we could have people when they get old enough to sign a will or sign a contract so that when they die they can give their organ to another person that needs it. Then instead of putting a pig organ in you and perhaps getting a
