**Get Ready! You've just entered the Afters Zone at Chelan Middle School!**



What began in late October, now has over 100 students involved! CMS is off to a great start in its new after school program. There are two types of Afters classes at CMS. In Enrichment, students in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade have the opportunity to take classes after school once or twice a week for 6 weeks. These after school classes include digital photography, pottery, cooking and quilting. The TARGET Afters are offered throughout the school year and assist middle school students with math homework and skill building.
